

Some Bible Verses on Suffering

- We were called to suffer for doing good as Jesus did leaving us an example that we should follow in His steps (1 Peter 2:20-25).
- No servant is greater than his master. They persecuted Jesus and will therefore persecute us (John 15:20).
- We are worthy to suffer for Christ because we bear His name. (Acts 5:41).
- Suffering produces perseverance, character and hope that does not disappoint us because God has poured out His love into our heart by the Holy Spirit (Romans 5:18).
- Glory will be revealed in us from our suffering for Christ (Romans 8:18).
- We are comforted in our sufferings (2 Cor. 1:5).
- Our struggle is against the spiritual forces of evil (Ephesians 6:12).
- It has been granted to believe on Jesus and also to suffer for him (Philippians 1:29).
- We have fellowship with Jesus when we share in His suffering (Philippians 3:10).
- Anyone who lives a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted (2 Timothy 3:12).
- Suffering strengthens our faith and proved genuine when Jesus is revealed (1 Peter 1:6-7).
- Suffering rids us of sin (1 Peter 4:1)!
- We are to rejoice in suffering with Christ and will be overjoyed when His glory is revealed. We are not to suffer for doing evil but for doing good so His glory rests on us. (1 Peter 4:12-16).
- Some suffering is from God's discipline so that we can share in His holiness and produces righteousness and peace (Hebrews 12:10-11).
- We can and should rejoice in our suffering that tests our faith and develops perseverance and maturity (James 1:2-4).
- God has endured all of this and suffered more than we can ever imagine out of His amazing love for us (1 John 4:19).
