Jesus' Second Coming

Some Old Testament prophecies of Jesus' second coming:

- † Isaiah 9:6-7: The government will be on the shoulders of “The Prince of Peace” and He will reign with justice and righteousness forever.
- † Ezekiel 37:24-28: God’s Servant “David” will be Israel’s Prince forever through an everlasting covenant and God will dwell with them. They will be His people and He will be their God.
- † Daniel 9:20-27: God’s Anointed One will bring in everlasting righteousness at the end of the “70 7s.”
- † Zechariah 14:1-9: The “Day of the Lord” is described and the Lord will be king over the whole earth.

Some New Testament prophecies of Jesus' second coming:

- † Matthew 24:3-35 and Luke 21:7-28: Some will come claiming they are the Christ; there will be wars and rumors of wars, famines, pestilences and earthquakes - the beginnings of “birth pains”.
- † 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18: We will all be changed and be caught up to meet Jesus in the air.
- † 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4: The rebellion will occur and the man of lawlessness (anti-christ) will be revealed.
- † 1 Corinthians 15:51-58: We will all be changed in the twinkle of an eye at the last trumpet when the dead in Christ will rise and those who love Jesus and are still alive will follow them.
- † 2 Timothy 3:1-5: The terrible times in the last days are described here.
- † 2 Peter 3:3-4: People will follow their evil desires in the last days.
- † Revelation 19:11-16: Jesus will come with the armies of heaven for war.
