

# The Miracle of Israel

The prophecies in the Bible are numerous and miraculous. They are given to us from a loving God for hope, peace and guidance. He loves us and is in complete control. The following is a focus on the prophecies of Israel; another proof that the Bible is the only book in history that contains God's prophecies, His loving plan and intentions for you and me.

- 1) God made a covenant (promise) that He will establish a nation from Abraham's offspring that will be everlasting. (Genesis 17:7).
- 2) No nation in history has ever survived destruction and a scattering of the people only to come back as a nation again with its language and customs except for the nation of Israel. It was prophesied that they will be scattered. (Leviticus 26:33)
- 3) Not only will they be scattered around the world, they will be few in number. (Deuteronomy 4:27). There are only 12 million Jews worldwide out of 6 billion people in the world.
- 4) They will be persecuted. Six million alone died in the holocaust. (Leviticus 26:3)
- 5) God will take the few and scattered and make them a light for all the nations. (Isaiah 49:6)
- 6) How would that happen if the land of Israel is to be desolate as predicted in Leviticus 26:32?
- 7) The answer is that the Jews were predicted to return to the land and at that time, the barren desolate land will flourish again and blossom. (Ezekiel 36:8; Amos 9:14; Zephaniah 3:20)
- 8) The exiles scattered around the world are to be gathered back to their ancient homeland (Jeremiah 29:14; 31:7-9; Ezekiel 37:12; Zechariah 8:8). Consider the miracle of the 1948 war of Israel (600,000 Jews) against 30,000,000 Arabs (likely well over 40,000,000).
- 9) The language also is to be restored (Hebrew) after a handful of Jews were scattered around the world into many nations, languages and cultures. Six million Jews now live in Israel and speak Hebrew where this was not spoken there just a hundred years ago. (Zephaniah 3:9)
- 10) A day is coming when many nations will gather together to battle Israel. (Zechariah 14:2)
- 11) There will be spiritual revival in Israel (Zechariah 8:23). There is now planning and discussion to build the Third Temple. They are training Levitical Priests and have created many articles of the Temple.
- 12) Ezekiel has a lot to say about Israel:
  - 1) The valley of dry bones (37:10-14)
  - 2) One nation under one King (37:15-28)
  - 3) Nations will come against Israel (Chapters 38 and 39)
  - 4) The new temple (Chapters 40 to 47)
- 13) Ultimately, a new Jerusalem, a new Heaven and a new Earth will come. (Revelations 21)
