

# Free Indeed

- ◆ **John 14: 6** states that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life. We cannot come to God the Father except through Jesus.
- ◆ **John 8:31-36** states, as believers in Jesus Christ, you will **know** the truth, and the truth sets us free. If Jesus sets us free, we are free indeed.
