What do you believe the word “redeem” means?

What is the story behind God’s redemption of the human race?

1) Our first parents did what to destroy their relationship with God?

2) This led to the curse that resulted in what consequences to creation?

3) Why did God curse His creation? (Why not just ignore it?)

4) What did God plan in response to the curse to restore Mankind to Himself?

5) Why was a Ransom or Payment needed?

6) What was an important qualification of the Ransom to be paid?

7) After the Payment He made on our behalf, what is now required on our part to benefit from it?

8) Why did God even bother to go through all of this?

Questions:

- 1) Are there any sins you have committed that you believe are too great to be redeemed?
- 2) Why do we sometimes feel and act as if our sins ARE too great to be redeemed?
- 3) How might you help others to come to the knowledge of God’s Gift of redemption that they too may be saved and set free?
