

## 2) **Salvation:** How Do We Get Saved?

- **Repent** (Metanoeo) - (to think differently / reconsider (to feel compunction morally) - (Matthew 4:17).
  - ▷ Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regrets (2 Corinthians 7:10).
  - ▷ Worldly sorrow brings death (2 Corinthians 7:10).
- **Believe** (Pisteuo) - “to have faith / entrust”. - (John 3:16).  
By just “believing” Jesus lived does not make you a Christian any more than believing Hitler lived makes you a Nazi.
  - ▷ Demonic faith (James 2:19)
  - ▷ Dead faith (James 2:17; 26)
  - ▷ Dynamic (saving) faith (James 2:21-24)
- **Receive** (Lambano) - to take hold of; “to accept and be amazed”; (to give oneself to another - yield my will to Christ) - (John 1:12)  
By yielding / surrender to Jesus as our Lord (Romans 10:9-10):
  - ▷ We receive His position in our lives as our “Dad” (Galatians 4:4-7).
  - ▷ We receive His person (Spirit) who lives in us (2 Timothy 1:14).
  - ▷ We receive His eternal family (Ephesians 2:19)
  - ▷ We receive His peace (Philippians 4:6-7), power (2 Timothy 1:7), purpose (Ephesians 2:10), protection (2 Thessalonians 3:3), passion (Psalm 37:4), provisions (1 Timothy 6:17) and promises (Jeremiah 29:11-13).
